Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are delighted to inform you that the Humanities department will be running a trip to The Holocaust Museum, on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2020.

This 4.5 hour educator led programme is designed for KS3 students and considers the choices made by ordinary people and the extent to which they contributed to the Holocaust. The programme will develop students' knowledge of the events of the Holocaust and their awareness of the causes and complexities of the Holocaust. During the programme students will visit the Holocaust exhibition, the memorial gardens and participate in a workshop exploring 'choices'. There is also the unique opportunity for the students to listen to the testimony of a survivor and to ask them questions.

Students will be required to meet at the front entrance of the Academy at 9:00 am and we will travel to Laxton (just outside of Newark) by coach. We will leave Laxton at 2:40pm and it is estimated that we will be back at the Academy by 3:30 pm depending on traffic. Including travel, the cost of the trip is £14 this is required with the reply slip to secure a place by Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2020. Please ensure you complete and return the trip consent form attached. Your child will need to bring a packed lunch on that day, free school meal students will be provided one on the day. For students in receipt of the Pupil Premium Grant, a text has been sent home to advise the subsidy that we are able to offer.

Please remember your child will need to be in correct school uniform.
