In keeping with our commitment to provide students with outstanding careers guidance and tailored support when choosing their next step after school, we will now be using Unifrog; an award-winning, online careers platform. All students in Years 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 now have access to this excellent website.

Unifrog brings into one place information and resources on careers guidance, every undergraduate university course, apprenticeship, and college course in the UK, as well as other opportunities, such as School Leaver Programmes, MOOCs and every college at Oxford and Cambridge. This makes it easy for students to look at industries, job roles, labour market information and education options, compare and choose the best university courses, apprenticeships or further education courses for them. They can also explore exciting opportunities further afield by looking at English taught undergraduate programmes available in Europe and the USA.

Additionally, the platform helps students successfully apply for future opportunities by supporting with writing their personal statements, applications and CVs and guiding them through the process, allowing teachers to give live feedback. There are also sections to support with well-being.

Students access the tool for the first time through a welcome email sent to their school address. They should check their spam folder in case the email has arrived there.

They then log in at www.unifrog.org/sign-in using their **school email address** and **password** and they can do so from any computer, tablet or smartphone. We would encourage you to use the platform with your child so you can support them through the process of deciding their next step.

If they forget their password or don't receive the email, students can visit the sign-in page and click **Forgotten Password**. They will then receive an email to reset.
