



Covid-19 Control Measures

How we will minimise someone accessing the site with symptoms

- One controlled entrance and exit to the school site & staggered arrival for students as necessary.
- Temperature testing on arrival (outdoor facility with designated staff using PPE).
- Clear and frequent reminders of symptoms & grounds for self-isolation to all parents, students and staff.
- Strict limitation on visitors to the site (controls at reception) & 'zoom' meetings where possible.
- No site access for parents – telephone calls to replace meetings.
- Reduced and controlled number of students on site at any time.

How we will ensure we comply with social distancing requirements

- Signage details the 1-way system across the site.
- 3 strands of provision (ESS, Y12 and Y10) operating in separate parts of the school.
- Class sizes reduced to ensure the 2-metre rule is adhered to and classes of no more than 15 students.
- Students (including ESS) placed in small consistent 'groups' and assigned designated taped off 'zones' across the site, with limited student movement within the zone only.
- Only staff to move freely around the school, including to teach in the specified classrooms.
- Amendment to Behaviour Policy and Code of Conduct detailing safe & unsafe behaviour and consequences.
- Student friendly 'Expectations' document & signed agreement from parents
- Toilets operate 1 in, 1 out system
- Parents asked to avoid sending their child on school transport (bus or taxi).
- Staff to adhere to maximum 15 per room & 2 metres distance.

How we will minimise the potential for spreading the virus whilst in school

- Thorough and ongoing clean of entire school, including deep clean as required and on-site cleaning throughout the day, including through the re-deployment of staff
- Anti-viral fogging of school site prior to opening and in response to suspected or confirmed cases
- Full disinfection of water system
- Maximising ventilation of rooms at all times with windows and doors open (with the exception of fire doors).
- Routine scheduled supervised handwashing for students and reminders for all.

- ALL refreshments, break time snacks and lunch to be eaten in 'zones' NOT in the Hub.
- Advice given to all students regarding the journey to and from school and avoidance of congregating in groups.
- Teachers deliver lessons in larger teaching spaces, e.g. sports hall, hub, West Hall, etc. with a standardised layout, taped corridors to ensure social distancing
- Outdoor 'classrooms' will be available & the curriculum & dress code modified accordingly
- Larger groups 'assemble' through the use of 'Zoom', with lessons/assemblies projected on screens to students in several classrooms
- The sharing of resources is limited so this is rarely the case i.e. textbooks, resource sheets, computers and name cards on desks with students 'owning' space (not moving around)
- PPE distributed as appropriate (gloves, masks, aprons) and hand sanitiser/antibacterial wipes available for all staff
- Clear protocols are in place complying with current guidance for those exhibiting symptoms during the school day, including isolation room and relevant safety measures, including fogging and deep cleaning
- 14 day 'quarantine' for staff & students who have come into contact with confirmed case.
